

Pro Tools Keyboard Shortcuts for Windows Systems



For increased operational speed and ease-of-use, there are many Pro Tools keyboard shortcuts to give you fast access to a wide variety of tasks. *This guide details the many keyboard shortcuts that are not shown within Pro Tools menus.* The shortcuts are grouped by functional area for your added convenience and quick reference.

GLOBAL KEYBOARD COMMANDS

Change all audio channel strips Alt - applicable function

Change audio channel strip and all selected

audio channel strips Alt - shift - applicable function

applicable functions:

- automation mode
- record, solo and mute enables
- record and solo safes
- volume/peak indicator
- track heights
- playlist enables
- creating Plug-Ins instances
- I/O, Bus, Send assignment
- extend selection
- clear clip meter

Toggle item & set all others to same new state Alt - click on applicable item

Toggle item & set all others to opposite state Ctrl - click on applicable item

applies to:

- tracks in Show/Hide Tracks List
- Group enables/activation
- Automation Enable window
- memory location parameters

Fine Tune Ctrl - click on control slider/pot/breakpoints

applies to:

- Plug-In parameter editing
- fader movement
- scrubbing
- automation data trimming (requires larger track view for highest resolution)


MIX AND EDIT GROUPS

Temporarily isolate channel strip from Group operation ... hold down Start/right mouse click - any operation that affects Groups

New Group Ctrl - G (with two or more tracks selected)

Suspend/Resume all Groups Ctrl - Shift - G or Ctrl - click on Groups pop-up menu

Rename Group double-click to far left of group name in the Groups List

Group Enable/Disable type ID letter on keyboard (To enable keyboard selection of Groups, click  box at top right of Groups List)

Hide all Tracks Click on track symbol in Show/Hide menu

Show Group members only right mouse click on group(s) in Groups List
(right mouse click - Shift - click for multiple groups)

Grouping affects:

- volume level/faders
- solos and mutes
- automation modes
- track display format
- track height
- editing
- playlist enables

Grouping does not affect:

- record enables
- pan
- voice and output assignments
- creating instances of TDM Plug-Ins

RECORD AND PLAYBACK

Open <i>New Track</i> DialogCtrl - Shift - N
In <i>New Track</i> Dialog cycle through track typeCtrl - </>
Cycle up/down through <i>New Track</i> optionsCtrl - ↑/↓
Start recordCtrl - spacebar/F12
Stop recordspacebar
Stop record and discard takeEsc or Ctrl - period key
Start/stop playbackspacebar
Half-speed recordCtrl - Shift - spacebar
Half-speed playbackShift - spacebar
Pause (pre-prime deck for instant playback & record)Start - spacebar or Alt- click on Transport play button
Enable/disable online recordCtrl - Alt - spacebar
Enable/disable online playbackCtrl - J / Alt - spacebar
Toggle record modes (normal/Destructive/Loop/QuickPunch)right mouse click on Transport record button
Loop playback toggleStart - click or right mouse click on Transport play button
Record-safe trackCtrl - click on Record enable button
Solo-safe trackCtrl - click on Solo button
QuickPunchCtrl - Shift - P
Enter/Exit record during playback in QuickPunchCtrl - spacebar/click on Transport record button
Set and enable pre/post-roll timeAlt - click with selector before/after selection
Disable pre/post-roll timeAlt - click within selection closer to front/back
Scroll to selection start/end←/→ (when selection exceeds window view)
Toggle Transport Master (Pro Tools/Machine/MMC)Ctrl - \

AUDITIONING

When Transport = Pro Tools:

Play by pre-roll value up to selection start/endAlt - ←/→
Play by post-roll value after selection start/endCtrl - ←/→
Play by pre & post-roll value through selection start/endCtrl - Alt - ←/→
Play by pre-roll value to current location counter timeAlt - ←/→ (when no selection)
Play by post-roll value from current location counter timeCtrl - ←/→ (when no selection)


When Transport = Machine/MMC:

Cue transport to selection start/endCtrl - ←/→
Cue transport with pre/post-roll to selection start/endAlt - ←/→

SCRUB (JOG) / SHUTTLE

Temporary scrub mode when using Selectorright mouse click - drag
Extend selection while scrubbingShift - click - drag w/ Scrubber, (also in temporary scrub mode)
ShuttleAlt - click - drag w/ Scrubber, (also in temporary scrub mode)
Shuttle-lockStart - number key (1-9, where 5 = real-time, 9 = max speed)
Change direction during Shuttle+/- (eg. shuttle backward = Start - number key - minus key)
Shuttle-lock stop0 (press number key to resume shuttle)
Exit Shuttle-lock modespacebar or Esc

EDITING, NUDGING & TRIMMING

(+/- key usage is on numeric keypad only)

Nudge data within current region to right/left by Nudge value (keeps region start/end and moves underlying audio)	Start - +/-
Nudge left selection boundary right/left by Nudge value.	Alt - Shift - +/-
Nudge right selection boundary right/left by Nudge value.	Ctrl - Shift - +/-
Nudge back/forward by next Nudge value	see Command Focus Mode section of this guide
Trim left edge of region to right/left by Nudge value	Alt - +/-
Trim right edge of region to right/left by Nudge value	Ctrl - +/-
Reverse Trimmer direction when trimming region	Alt - Trimmer
Trim up to, but not over, adjacent regions.	hold down Ctrl key while trimming
Duplicate region(s) in Edit Window	Ctrl - click selection and drag to destination
Delete selection in playlist	Backspace
Constrain audio region to vertical movement	right mouse click - move audio region with Grabber
Snap region start to stationary playhead or edit selection start	Start - click new region with Grabber
Snap region to stationary playhead or edit selection sync point.	Alt - Start - click new region with Grabber
Snap region end to stationary playhead or edit selection start.	Ctrl - Start - click new region with Grabber

Horizontal zoom in/out	.Ctrl -] / [

M E M O R Y L O C A T I O N S

Create memory location	.Enter (on numeric keypad)
Reset a memory location	.Start - click on memory location button
Delete memory location	.Alt - left mouse click on a memory location button
Recall a memory location	.period key - memory location number - period key or click on memory location button*



F A D E S

- Apply xfade to selection without accessing Fades window . . .Ctrl - Start - F (uses last selected fade shape)
- Edit fade-in only in Fades windowAlt - click - drag fade-in curve (in "None" Link mode only)
- Edit fade-out only in Fades windowCtrl - click - drag fade-out curve (in "None" Link mode only)
- Audition start/stop in Fades windowspacebar
- Reset to default zoom in Fades windowCtrl - click on either zoom arrow
- Reset standard or S-shape crossfades to default curvesAlt - click in xfade window (in Equal Power/Gain modes)
- Cycle up/down through Out Shape parameter optionsStart - ↑/↓
- Cycle up/down through In Shape parameter optionsAlt - ↑/↓
- Cycle up/down through Link parameter options↑/↓
- Cycle up/down through preset Out Shape curvesStart - ←/→
- Cycle up/down through preset In Shape curvesAlt - ←/→

R E G I O N S L I S T

- Select region by nametype letter(s) A-Z (To enable keyboard selection of Regions, click  box at top right of Regions List)
- Clear selected region(s) from Regions ListShift - Ctrl - B
- Bypass dialog boxes during deletion of audio filesAlt - click "delete"/"yes" button in respective dialog
- Audition region in Regions ListAlt - click & hold on region in Regions List
- Rename region/filedouble-click region in Regions List or double-click with Grabber on region in playlist
- Constrain region placement to start at play/edit cursor location or selection startright mouse click and drag region

I M P O R T A U D I O D I A L O G

- Add currently selected audio region/file to listAlt - A
- Convert & import currently selected audio region/file to listAlt - O
- Remove currently selected audio file/regionAlt - R
- Remove all audio files/regionsAlt - M
- Audition currently selected audio file/regionSpacebar
- Stop audition of selected file and retain selectionSpacebar
- Stop audition of selected file & go to top of scroll boxHome

MIXING

Make track Active/Inactive	Click on track symbol in Mix window while holding control and start keys
Set all faders to their automation null points	Alt - click on either automatch triangle
Reset a control to default value	Alt - click on control
Headroom/Track Level/Channel Level Indicator	Ctrl - click on Track Level Indicator
Clear peak/clip-hold from meter	click on indicator
Peak counter reset in Headroom Indicator mode	click on Headroom Indicator
Bypass Plug-In Insert	Ctrl - click on insert name in Inserts view
Send mute	Ctrl - click on send name in Sends view
Toggle Send Display between "All" & "Individual" mode	Ctrl - click on Send pop up
Bypass Delay Compensation View indicators and fields	Start-Control - click on Plug-In Delay, User Delay or Track Delay Compensation

AUTOMATION

Leave extremity breakpoints undisturbed while trimming ...	hold down Shift key while trimming
Disable auto-creation of anchor breakpoints when trimming automation	Alt - Trimmer
Access Plug-In Automation dialog	Ctrl - Alt - Start - click on Parameters (in Plug-in window) track display format selector (in Edit window)
Enable/Disable Plug-In Automation	Ctrl - Alt - Start - click on Parameters (in Plug-in window) track display format selector (in Edit window)
Disable/enable automation playlist on selected track	Ctrl - click on track display format selector
Disable/enable ALL automation playlists on selected track ...	Ctrl - Shift - click on track display format selector
Vertically constrain automation movement	Shift - move automation with Trimmer
Special Paste of automation data between different controls ..	Start - Ctrl - V
Write automation to end of session/selection	Start - click or right mouse click on Transport End button

Copy to Send	Ctrl - Alt - H
Display Automation Playlist of automation-enabled control. ...	Ctrl - right mouse click on control

(Track defaults: disk=waveform; MIDI=notes; aux/master=volume)	
Scroll to & select track in Mix/Edit window	right mouse click on track name in Mix, Edit, Insert or Sends window or Show/Hide Tracks List
When all tracks in selection are displaying automation playlists, hold down Start key during the following operations to affect all playlists on every track in selection:

NUMERIC ENTRY

- Initiate time entry in Current Location & Big Counters . . . *
- Initiate time entry in Edit window Start/End/Length fields . . . / (subsequent presses toggle through fields)
- Initiate time entry in Transport window fields Alt - / numeric keypad (subsequent presses toggle through fields)
- Capture incoming timecode in Session Setup window (with Start field selected),
Spot dialog & Time Stamp Selected dialog = (hold down key for continued input)
- Move sub-unit selection to the right period key
- Move sub-unit selection to the left/right ←/→
- “Calculator entry” mode + or – keys followed by offset number
- Increment/decrement the current sub-unit ↑/↓
- Clear entered numeric value & stay in time entry mode . . . Retype value
- Apply entered numeric value Enter
- Clear entered numeric value and exit time entry mode . . . Esc

Note: When Time Code is the selected time scale, initiating time entry highlights entire field, and numeric values are entered right to left

M I S C E L L A N E O U S

Display Takes Pop Up list (appears only when selection start or flashing insertion point matches user time stamp of regions)Ctrl - click with Selector tool at selection start or current cursor location

Set all tracks to selected record drive in

Disk Allocation dialogAlt - click on record drive

Access Playback Engine dialog during Pro Tools launchhold down "N" key while launching Pro Tools

Toggle between Hide All and Show AllAlt - click in Show/Hide Tracks List

Bypass repeat dialogs when multiple items will be changed by single operation (eg. Clear, Delete, Compact)Alt - click respective "Proceed" button in dialog

Increase or decrease track heightStart+up arrow or start+down arrow
